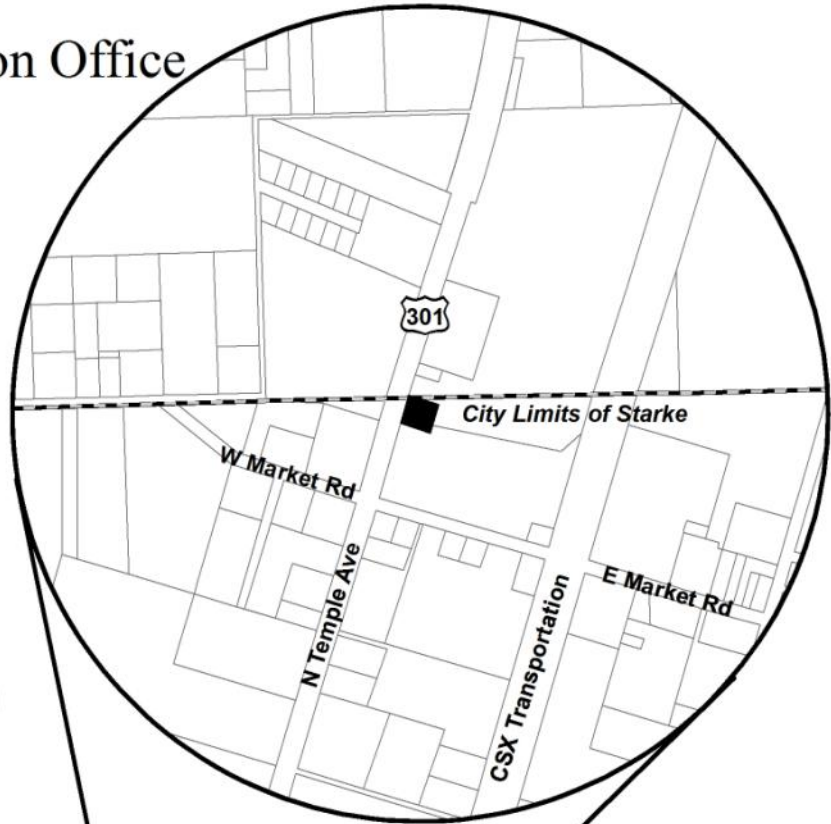
- Crop Selection
